Letter 524 of the Ministry of Industry and Trade mentioned above extends the prohibition period from previously 21 January 2004 through to 31 August 2004 to 21 January 2004 through to 31 December 2004, such that resumption of rice imports will be on 1 January 2005 through until 1 (one) month prior to grand rice harvest of 2005.
